## **BACHELOR OF ARCHITECTURE (B.Arch)**

Five-year degree programme approved by Council of Architecture

#### **Eligibility**

- 10+2 with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics; and an overall aggregate of 50% in 10+2.
- OR An aggregate of at least 50% in 10+3 diploma examinations with mathematics as a compulsory subject and NATA qualifying score (as per COA guidelines).



Two-year degree programme approved by Council of Architecture

#### **Eligibility**

- B. Arch degree recognized by the Council of Architecture -Minimum 50% aggregate marks.
- For International Students Undergraduate degree in Architecture with a Minimum 50% aggregate marks and PGETA qualifying score (as per COA guidelines)
- Additionally, candidates shortlisted must present their academic/ professional portfolio during their personal interviews with the panel.







# BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS (B.F.A. in Applied Arts/ Painting)

Four - year degree programme approved by the Haryana State Government

#### **Eligibility**

- Minimum pass marks aggregate in 10+2 (any stream) from a recognised board or equivalent.
- Qualify an aptitude test in the form of an interactive session/ interview. Candidates must present their work portfolio to the panel during their interview.



Five - years Dual Degree Programme approved by ITPI

#### **Eligibility**

Senior Secondary Examination (12 th grade) with Mathematics and English with at least 50% marks (45% for SC/ST) in aggregate.

OR

10+3 Diploma in any stream having Mathematics and English as courses and recognized by Central/State Government with 50% (45% for SC/ST) marks in aggregate. Any other examination recognized equivalent there to.

## **DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY**

(Ph.D in Architecture, Planning, Fine Arts, Applied Arts & Allied Subjects)

#### **Eligibility**

- Master's degree or equivalent in relevant discipline with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate.
- M.Phil degree with at least 55% marks or equivalent shall also be eligible.



## MASTER OF PLANNING (M.Plan in Urban /Tranport Planning)

Two - years degree programme recognised by ITPI

#### Eligibility

- An undergraduate degree in Planning/ Architecture/ Civil Engineering or Post Graduate degree in Geography/Economics/ Sociology for Urban Planning and Statistics/Operational Research/Economics for Transport Planning from recognised University/ Institution in India or Abroad recognized by the Government of India.
- A minimum of 55% aggregate marks is required in the undergraduate or postgraduate degree as applicable\*
